#### Solution

3p, 6p, 7p, 11p, 12p, 15p, 21p,  
22p, 25p, 30p.

#### Extensions

What if Suzy put three of her coins in her money box?

The possible answers then are:

8p, 13p, 16p, 17p, 23p, 26p, 27p, 31p, 32p, 35p.

What if Suzy had a 50p coin as well?

If she puts two of them in the money box, there are 15 possible answers.

If she puts in three of the coins, there are 20 possible answers.

Find the total of two or three coins  
Think logically and work systematically
