Each ladybird had the same number of spots on both wings.

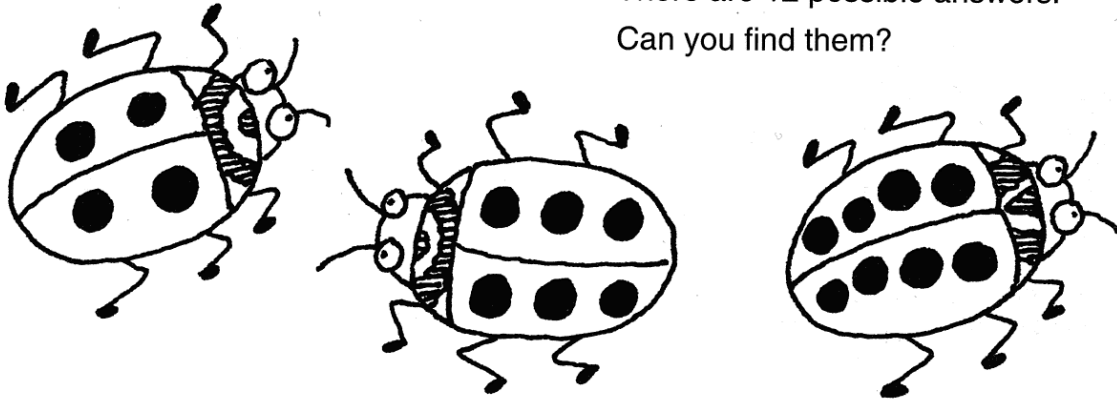
Each ladybird was different.
